Earlier this term a few of the young people enjoyed an introduction to the gentle pastime of angling on the River Weaver, and yes, they did catch a few fish



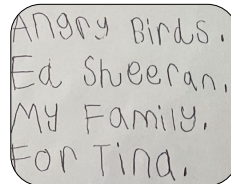
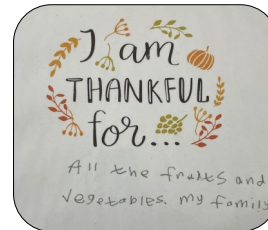
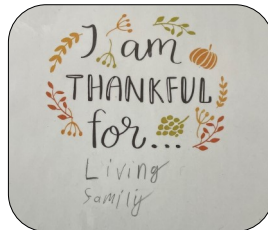
MULTI-ACTIVITY

This term we celebrated Thanks Giving, all the young people enjoyed a turkey dinner, and discussed what they were thankful for.



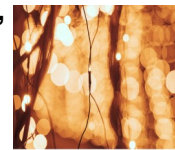
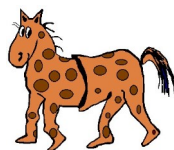
Resi took on spooky feel on Halloween, when we decorated the apartments and made some ghoulish arts and crafts.
