


In March inspectors arrived to complete the residential inspection. Here is some feed back:

- Children receive individualised care from a stable and committed staff team.
- Children are comfortable with staff and they have fun together.
- Careful matching means that children get to spend time with their friends and other children that they get along with.
- Children spoken to talked happily about their time in residential. They told the inspector that their time there was 10 out of 10.
- Children have clear targets that are realistic and achievable, and they make progress.
- Children recognise that the care and support they receive from residential staff helps them in their lives.
- Staff demonstrate a good understanding of children's individual risks and vulnerabilities.
- Staff use lots of praise to promote children's positive behaviours. This is reflected in the calm and settled atmosphere
- Children told the inspectors that they felt safe and that they could share any concerns they had with staff
