## School Attendance update

A number of parents have made contact with school this week about new school attendance arrangements brought in by government from September.

Firstly, thank you for contacting school before 9:00am if your child in not going to be able to attend school **and** providing a reason- this is really important as school has to record the reason for absence. If a reason is not given then the absence is recorded as unauthorized.

A school day is made up of 2 sessions (morning and afternoon). That means one day of unauthorized absence = 2 sessions. If a pupil is absent for 10 sessions during a term (which is 5 days), a fine is issued. The fine is **£160** (if paid =within 28 days) or **£80** if paid within 21 days. Page 6 of the attendance policy (which is posted on the school website), provides more detailed information about the fines arrangements.

School is trying to manage a very difficult issue. We are ambitious for all children to attend school regularly. If they do not- how can they learn and develop the skills they need to prepare for the next steps? Authorized absences may include medical appointments or illness. These do not count towards a fine.

School will make contact with families to offer support and try to find out the reasons for erratic attendance. We do not want to issue fines but will be challenged and judged by Ofsted and the Local Authority if we do not try and manage attendance effectively.
