FOR INFORMATION: Amber warning of extreme heat affecting North West England

The Amber warning that was issued by the Met Office this week for extreme heat on Sunday, has now been extended to include all day Monday and Tuesday and includes CW&C.

School Actions:

- Pupils are encouraged to wear a hat outside.
- Pupils may wear shorts and t-shirts during next week. **P.E. kit is a suitable alternative.**
- School has two cool water fountains in school. Pupils will continue to be encouraged to drink water during the day.
- An order has been placed for ice pops, that pupils can have for free.
- During breaks pupils will be encouraged to use the shade available in school.
- Classroom windows and doors will be open to encourage the circulation of air.
- If required, pupils can access the air conditioned ICT suites.
- Families are encouraged to use sunscreen for their child before they attend school.
